**THE HONOURABLE JOE VOLPE, P.C., M.P.
QUESTION ON AIRLINE PASSENGER RIGHTS
NOVEMBER 19, 2009**

Mr. Speaker, last year, the House unanimously approved a Liberal motion on the passenger safety and services provided by the airlines.
